Admission Requirements

For admission to the University of Iowa, transfer applicants:

- Must have a cumulative grade-point average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on at least 24 semester hours earned after high school graduation (36 quarter hours) of acceptable graded credit, OR
- An Associate of Arts (AA) Degree or an Associate of Science (AS) Degree from an Iowa community college, and a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher on acceptable graded credit from all colleges attended, OR
- Students with fewer than 24 semester hours will be considered for admission based on a combination of high school and college academic records, as well as ACT or SAT scores.

The above requirements are for admission into the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Other colleges may have additional pre-requisite and/or GPA requirements.

Application Deadlines

- Fall semester – July 15
- Spring semester – December 1
- Summer semester – May 1
