WHAT WE CONSIDER

To be considered for admission as a transfer student, you must be in good standing at your most recent institution and eligible to return to any previously attended institution.

IN ADDITION, YOU'LL NEED:

- One college-level composition course with a grade of Pass, Satisfactory, or C-minus or better
- One college-level mathematics course with a grade of Pass, Satisfactory, or C-minus or better
- Minimum GPA of 2.25 for Oregon residents, 2.50 for nonresidents
- Second-language proficiency (demonstrated by college or high school work)

If you do not meet one of our transfer requirements, you may complete a special circumstances statement. This statement should explain why we should consider an exception to our requirements. Students earning an associate of arts Oregon transfer degree from a community college may receive additional consideration even if they do not meet the above requirements.
